

Keno Variants

As well as some options that you can find for making different kinds of bets, or different combinations of wagers, you will also find that some sites and land-based casinos offer keno variants. We will take you through our favourites below.

Keno Poker

In keno poker, all of the numbers that are drawn are given a random card value and suit. After all of the numbers are up, the players also get the chance to bet on the resulting hand in a game of poker. This is one for those fans who like to mix things up between



Instant Bingo

The only difference between instant bingo and the **standard rules of keno** is that in this variant, players shuffle the order of the numbers on the card and get a random selection of numbers. This brings the game closer to bingo.



Roulette Keno

Roulette keno follows basic keno rules, with **the difference being in how the balls are drawn**. Rather than coming from a machine, specially designed for keno, a roulette wheel is used. Five balls are spun around the wheel to select the numbers in a scaled-down keno game.



Extra Draw Keno

Extra draw keno is, as it sounds, all about an extra draw that takes place after the usual 20 numbers have been drawn. Players take out a side bet on this number and if they match it, then they win, regardless of the result of their main bet.
